3. With the April time frame for awarding the contract, and legislative session ending at about the same time, will DRS be expecting any additional funding for this project?

5. Will the solution be managed by the state's Consolidated Technology Services (CTS) agency, or sit at CTS and be managed by the vendor or vendor partner?

Consolidated Technology Services (CTS) will host the solution. No decision regarding management of the solution will be made until after all qualifying proposals are evaluated.
