Thank you for your interest in the public records from the Department of Retirement Systems (DRS). Your request was received on 3/10/2026 and will be processed in accordance with the State of Washington Public Records Act, Chapter 42.56 RCW. For tracking purposes, your request reference number is P000992-031026.

Records Requested: An electronic document which lists any and all retired employees (members) which were paid a monthly pension annuity (payment) in the year 2025. Each member record should include the following: The member's full name, retirement date, last employer name, and monthly pension annuity (payment) amount in 2025. For reference, I have attached a small sample of the file we received when we made the same request for data from a prior year.

For reference, I have attached the 2024 report that we received last year.

Within five business days after receiving the request, we will do one of the following three things:

- Provide the records;
- Deny the public records request; or

- Acknowledge your request and give you a reasonable estimate of how long it will take to respond. Additional time to respond to a request may be based upon the following:
 - To clarify the intent of the request;
 - To locate, review and assemble the information requested;
 - To notify third persons or agencies affected by the request;
 - To determine whether any of the information requested is exempt and if a denial should be made as to all or part of the request. (State law requires us to cite the specific exemption from disclosure.)
 - Current workload and other pending requests

PLEASE NOTE: The State of Washington Public Records Act, Chapter 42.56 RCW, does not require a governmental body to create new information, records, to do legal research, or to answer questions. Most documents are available in electronic format. If the document(s) requested are not available electronically, we will make them available for inspection, by paper, or CD in accordance with the Public Records Act, Chapter 42.56 RCW.
